5 Step Process to Volunteer

- 1. Complete your Level 2 background screening
 - All parents/volunteers will need to have a Level 2 background screening to volunteer. For Level 2 background screening information please register on-line https://dospsep.org/
 - Recertification is every 5 years and fingerprints must be done through the diocese. No outside Level 2 fingerprints can be accepted.
 - Please do not wait on this because it is not immediate and can take a week or more to get back.
- 2. Complete the Safe Environment Training
 - All parents/volunteers must take the online Safe Environment Training course conducted by the Diocese prior to volunteering. https://stpetersburg.cmgconnect.org/.
 - Once you complete the training please print the certificate and hand in at front offic28.

3. Find Volunteer Opportunities

- Check with your teachers, ask room parents, read weekly school newsletter (comes out every Friday), read emails from school, ask the home and school family involvement coordinator, etc.
- Can donate to teacher-approved requests (Wish Points).
- 12 hours must be earned from selling 30 raffle tickets
- 2 hours must be earned from attending H & S mandatory meetings (1 hour for fall and 1 hour for spring)

4. Track hours

- Each family is responsible for submitting their hours on the parent portal in order to receive credit.
 - O Click forms once in the portal to input your hours.
- All hours should be entered by May 26 to not be charged \$40 per hour for all remaining hours

ALL Visitors and Volunteers

Everyone visiting the school, including parents, must first report to the office, sign in on computer, and receive a visitor or volunteer sticker that must be worn. No visitors are allowed to visit a class without permission from the office.

** If you are new to our school. You will first be asked to swipe you driver's license/ ID at the front office, to then be entered into the main volunteer sign in computer for future sign in.

Volunteer Opportunities

You will be invited to use Sign up Genius to "sign up" for many events and for classroom donations. Many volunteer opportunities are advertised in the Crusader newsletter each Friday and "All School" emails will be sent out with sign up information.

Attend Home and School Mandatory Meeting

Get school wide information for the year from H & S board and committee chairs. Sign ups for committees. Get 1 hour for attending the Fall and Spring Meetings (total 2 hours).

Date: Second or third Friday of each month

Come hear what is happening at SCS. Monthly H & S meetings are held in the teacher's lounge from approx. 8:00-9:00am. Please come hear from our principal, chairpersons and board on events going on at school. Come share your ideas! Volunteer hours credited for attending.

Wish Points

You can donate to teacher-approved requests (Wish Points). Purchases made at the request of a teacher for various class activities are credited toward hours at the rate of \$40.00 per hour. Purchases being made at the request of a teacher for hours must be submitted on a Home & School Green Form with all receipts attached

and signed by teacher to receive credit. Please drop off green form and attached receipts to office. Volunteers should enter their wish point hours on the parent portal.

New Family Breakfast

New Families and Buddy Families come for a breakfast before school starts. Volunteer opportunities in the morning to help serve, check in guests, clean up after breakfast, etc.

Want to meet more SCS families. Volunteers will be needed to help set up, serve food and clean up. Evening hours for volunteering.

Room Parent

Sign up to be a room parent. This is a school year commitment. Room Parents are chosen by their homeroom teachers. Room Parent's assist the teacher with planning of parties, field trips, classroom activities, Field day, coverage for teacher when needed (teacher appreciation breakfast), etc. Also help communicate activities and events with the parents in your grade class.

Help Classroom Teachers

Contact your teacher if interested in at home hours. This could include cutting out items for a project, putting together binders for end of the year activities, creating bulletin boards, etc. Each classroom needs vary so please contact your teachers.

Field Trips

Parents in grades K-8 can attend field trips as chaperones. Field trips are a great way to earn hours and be with your child in a learning environment. Number of hours varies for each field trip as well as number of chaperones needed. Middle School overnight field trips are allocated a certain number of hours (7 hours per day for overnight)

Book fair

Our book fair is in the Fall and Spring. The chairperson works with Scholastic books and librarian to organize the event, plan the theme, decorate the library and coordinate the volunteers to work the 5-day sale. There will be hours needed for set up and clean up of the book fair displays. Helping the chairs run the book fair before and after school. Volunteers needed for am shifts before school and after school shifts.

• There are events that go with book fair (e.g. breakfast, snow cones) and hours will be available during these events which are usually before or after school. Look for a sign-up genius.

Drama

Our drama produces one play in the fall our Christmas production and one play in spring. Volunteers are needed during production times for various roles and times. Drama is also always looking for talented parents to help with set design and sewing of costumes. Hours are needed backstage after school during tech week (week of play at CCC High School). During the plays (which are usually in the evening hours at CCC) volunteers are needed to help with production and sale of the concession stand.
